Subject: ACB #L5/120 - Operation of Rotation Control

The rotation control sequence used to prevent the body x-axis from pitching through the downward vertical was written on the assumption that UNFC/2 was a unit vector. The unitizing operation was deleted from Luminary since FINDCDUW does it anyway. The formula used for release is:

$$\overline{A}_{T} \times 2^{9} \cdot \overline{X}_{NB} \times 2^{-1} > \cos \theta_{C} \times 2^{-2}$$

since $\overline{U}NFC/2 = \overline{A}_{\mp} \times 2^9$

$$(\overline{A}_{T} \times 2^{9}) \cdot \overline{X}_{NB} > 1/2 \cos \theta_{\overline{C}}$$

 $(A_{T} \times 2^{9}) \cos \theta > 1/2 \cos \theta_{C}$

Now, $A_T \ge 2^9$, instead of having a magnitude of 1/2, varies from .15 to .30, with the result that $\cos \theta$ must be larger than $\cos \theta_C$, or that θ must be smaller that θ_C . The attached figure shows the range of variation.
