will be custodians of a sign off

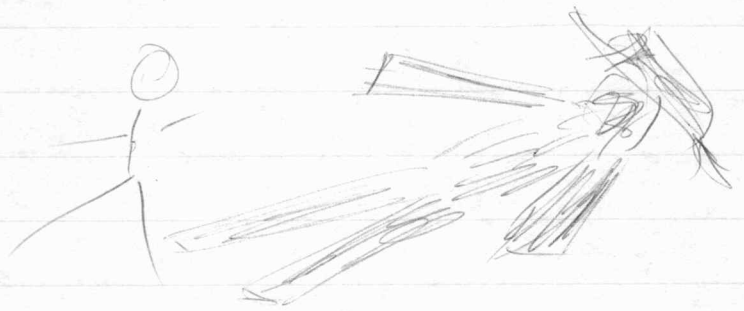
sheet for each ERASABLE. Without a complete sign-off the K-START tape will not be manufactured.

A K-START tape is a metal-mylar punched hole tape that physically is used to load the AGC's erasable memory prior to lift-off.

The next K-START (REV 2) for Apollo-14 will be THE one. So how about it gang? — if you got this memo look at your numbers very carefully & come to the "sign-off band".
