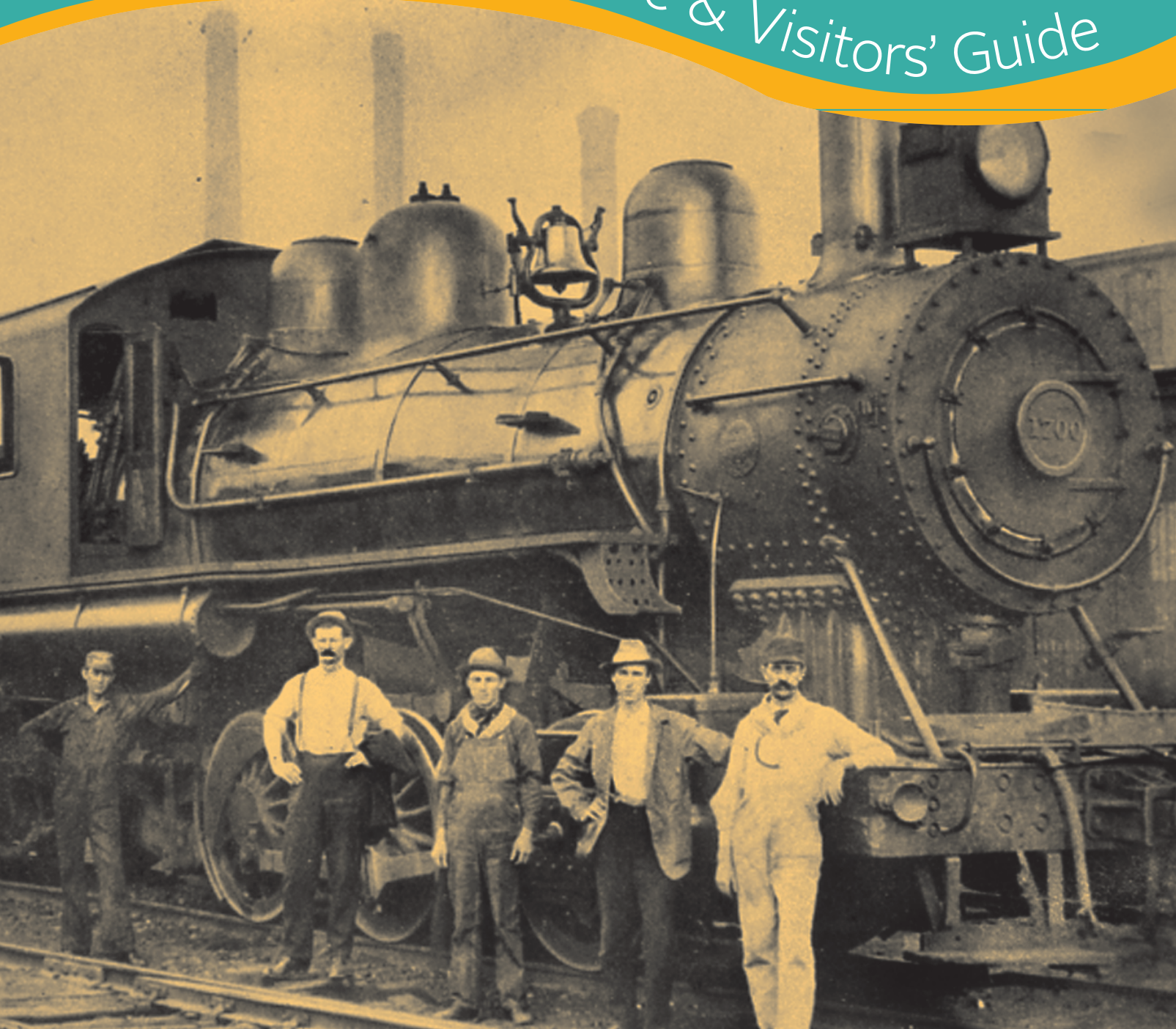

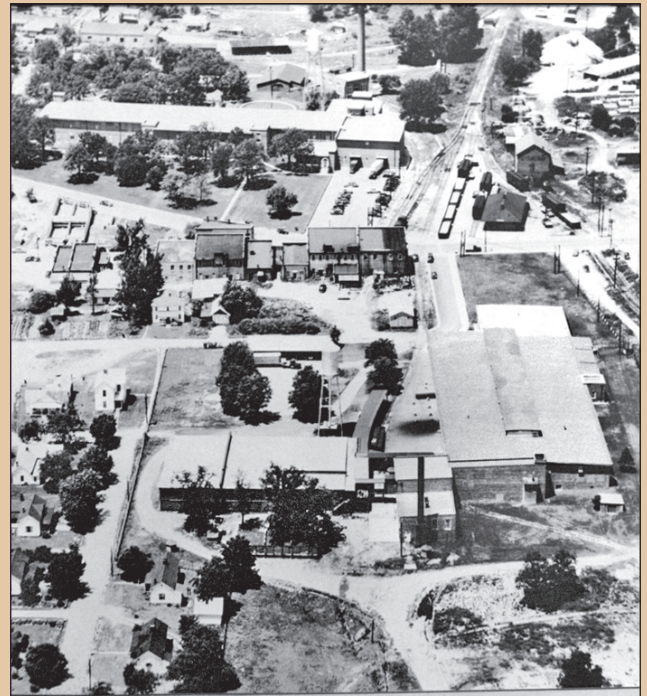
A Brief History of Carrboro

Today's Carrboro had humble beginnings. In 1882, University officials wanted rail service to bring students and others to its hallowed halls. They decided to locate the rail spur away from the bucolic campus in an area affectionately known as West Of (as in west of Chapel Hill). It was later adapted to West End before being changed to Lloydville when Tom Lloyd built his Alberta Cotton Mill here.

Transportation and commerce helped the settlement grow, and by 1911 it was incorporated. Locals renamed the town Venable in honor of the University's president. That didn't last long, though. Julian Carr bought the Alberta Mill and the town's name was again changed. This time it stuck. We've been called Carrboro since 1914.

The town was a manufacturing and transport hub for many years. The textile mills dominated the local economy until the early 1960s. At that time, about 2,000 people called Carrboro home. And unlike many towns that lose their main economic drivers, Carrboro survived.

These days, Carrboro retains its small town flavor despite having increased its population eight-fold to 17,000. Independent businesses continue to thrive here, and the original business district remains the center of commerce and community. Home to a robust creative class, the town is affectionately known as The Paris of the Piedmont. This guide showcases much of what makes Carrboro a great place to live, work and play.

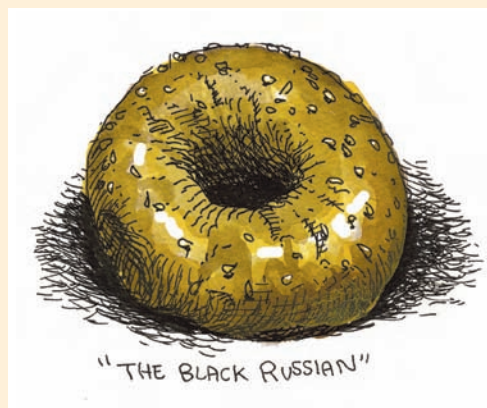
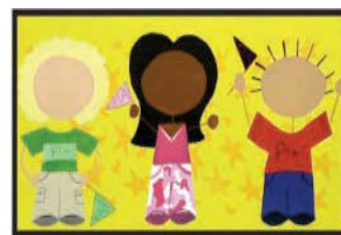

Carrboro Cuisine and Community

The national obsession with local food is getting Carrboro noticed. Recent articles in the national press – *Bon Appetit*, *Food & Wine*, *Forbes* – recognized our little burgh as a destination for great food made by great people with great local ingredients. So what if we're often lumped in with our larger neighbors to the east?

The heart of the local food scene is the year-round Carrboro Farmers' Market (Town Commons, carrborofarmersmarket.com). "People form a relationship with their food, their local restaurants, chefs, and home producers – and we live in a community that supports these efforts," says Market Manager Sarah Blacklin. "We have something other areas don't – a real community. Customers who shop at the Carrboro Farmers' Market do so alongside

Sheila and Matt Neal of Neal's Deli, Kevin Callaghan of Acme, Ricky Moore of Glasshalfull, and many other nationally renowned chefs. We know our local business owners, our neighbors, our chefs and our farmers."

Adds Callaghan, chef/owner of Acme Food & Beverage (110 E. Main St., acmecarrboro.com, 929-ACME): "There's a deep desire here to be a part of the community, and that includes buying from people you know. There's an economic and emotional incentive to participate in the local food economy. And Carrboro really embraces that. It's

part of our character to want to do things with meaning or value, like supporting local growers and restaurants."

Home cooks and restaurant chefs crave great ingredients at a fair price, and these are easy to find in town any day of the week. Local produce, proteins and other products are available at the Farmers' Market and Weaver St. Market (101 E. Weaver St., weaverstreetmarket.coop, 929-0010).

There's also plenty of good stuff available directly from local producers. Matt and Sheila Neal make the pastrami and corned beef served at Neal's Deli (100 E. Main St., nealsdeli.com, 967-2185). The folks at Hogan's Magnolia View Farm sell local wheat and grass-fed beef from their family homestead (918 Old N.C. 86, hogansbeef.com, 942-6090). And we have to be one of the smallest towns with locally-

roasted coffee, available at The Open Eye (101 S. Greensboro St., openeyecafe.com, 968-9410) and Jessee's (401 E. Main St., thekindcoffee.com, 929-0445).

"The best food you are ever going to eat is food that is grown and harvested where you live," says Moore, executive chef at Glasshalfull (106 N. Greensboro St., glasshalfullcarrboro.com, 967-9784). "Why? Because of the hard work that goes into growing food and the hard work that goes into preparing and cooking food, comes from individuals who are passionate about what they are doing and it is important for the residents to share in that experience."

Carrboro's live entertainment scene is known throughout the state. Live music, theatre, comedy and more are on tap nightly here in the Seattle of the South. Here are three of our biggest draws:

DSI Comedy

Peek around a loading dock at Carr Mill Mall and you'll find one of the top comedy theaters in the Southeast. "No one drops in happenstance,"

laughs owner Zach Ward, who opened DSI after a successful stint on the Chicago comedy scene. "When someone comes to the theater, they had to plan it." Now a destination for comedy fans throughout the state, DSI shows feature local talent as well as national touring comics every Friday and Saturday night. Having a family night? DSI's 7:30 pm Friday shows are improv slams with humor for all ages. Mark your calendars: DSI will host the annual NC Comedy Arts Festival

February 4-27, 2010, featuring talent from around the country.

What locals know: Shows often sell out the 84-seat theater, so call ahead for reservations.

Cat's Cradle

Ask any emerging band if they've played at "The Cradle." Chances are, if they haven't, they're either planning on it or wishing they had. Recently named in the *New York Times* as a hotspot for catching new music, the Cats Cradle has hosted a succession of great bands for the last 20 years. Owner and General Manager Frank Heath explains that, while the bands may be extremely different, there's never a bad show at the Cradle. Does it live up to the hype? With the largest space and the best sound system in town plus hot bands all week long, signs point to "Yes."

What locals know: There's always someone good at the Cradle, so check the website regularly.

Building a Better Local Economy

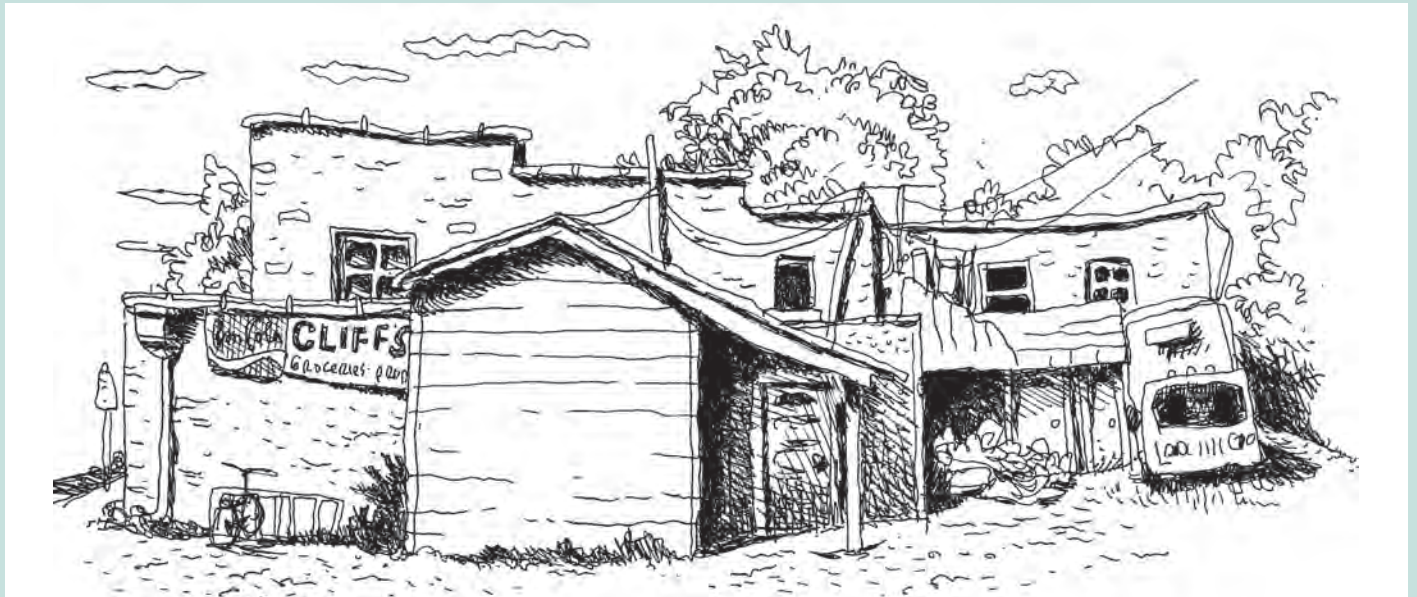

Since its beginning, Carrboro has been a hub of commerce. Two citizen advisory boards provide counsel and input to the Board of Aldermen to ensure the local economy continues to flourish.

Economic Sustainability Commission

Creating a sustainable business environment is critical to the long-term health of Carrboro's economy. The Economic Sustainability Commission (ESC) was formed to guide Town leaders in making business and development decisions that positively impact the community.

The ESC, chaired by Peter Lee, reviews the economic impact of all development requests submitted to the Town. ESC members consider how

each project affects residents, jobs, the environment and tax revenues.

The group also reviews applicants for the town's Revolving Loan Fund. Started with federal grant money in 1986, the Fund makes loans to both for-profit and non-profit entities based in Carrboro with the goal of growing businesses. The program has helped several small businesses get off the ground and become going concerns. Weaver Street Market, for instance, was the fund's first grantee. Local Living Economy Task Force

The Local Living Economy Task Force (LLETf) explores, evaluates and suggests strategies the Town can

deploy to foster the development of a locally-owned and -run economy. The LLETf is chaired by Sammy Slade.

In a landscape increasingly dotted with regional malls and cookie-cutter shopping centers and office parks, Carrboro is determined to retain its unique character. The LLETf hopes to do this by suggesting activities and policies that will nurture and support all forms of local business from retail shops to body shops, from the healing arts to the performing arts, from professional services to healthcare services, from fine dining to fine arts, from local farms to local families.

Busing

Chapel Hill Transit provides fare-free public transportation service in Carrboro, Chapel Hill and UNC. That's right – it's a free ride. Riders can take advantage of real-time schedules, park-and-ride lots and special service to Carolina football and basketball games. Routes, schedules and more information is available at chtransit.org, or by calling 969-4900.

Biking

Carrboro became an official Bicycle Friendly Community in 2004. Bike lanes and wide road shoulders make it easy to pedal around, whether you're commuting or taking a leisurely ride. Up & Coming: Veridia

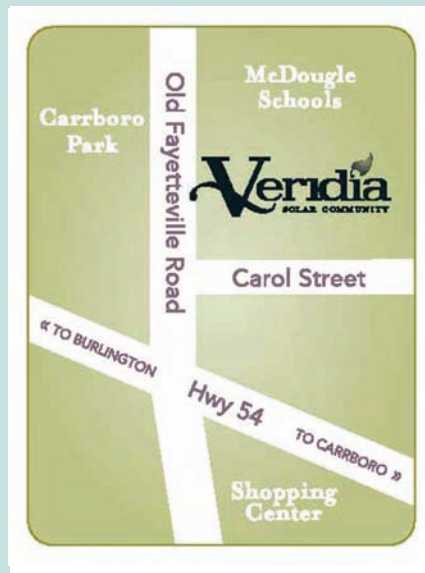

Carrboro residents have always cared about the land. Much of the acreage around downtown was farmland not that long ago. So it's no surprise that the town has its share of eco-friendly housing developments.

Veridia will be the town's first affordable green housing community just two miles from downtown - just north of Carol Street on Old Fayetteville Road. The project is the brainchild of local developers David Bell and Trip Overholt.

"Given the triple challenges of a difficult economy, dependence on foreign oil, and global warming, now is the perfect time for a development that is affordable and energy independent - minimizing carbon emissions without compromising quality of life," Overholt says.

Designed by local architect Giles Blunden, Veridia will meet the criteria for Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) Neighborhood Development, a rating system for sustainable building. It will include a 100-kilowatt photovoltaic solar array to offset the neighborhood's electrical use. Solar-thermal systems on each home will provide the majority



of hot water requirements. And rainwater harvested from roofs will be captured in underground cisterns to be reused for landscaping and toilet flushing.

Other features include a community house, vegetable garden and a playground. The two- and three-bedroom homes will be priced between \$260,000 and \$299,000.

"These homes are designed to meet the needs of both young families just starting and mature families who may be retiring or downsizing," says Blunden, principal of

Carrboro's Bluden Studio architectural firm. "The houses are so efficient that utility costs will be the lowest in our area."

The project, slated for completion in the fall of 2011, will set a standard for affordable green building in the community.

Says Bell: "We're convinced that compact, environmentally conscious neighborhoods clustered near downtown centers represent our best hope for transforming our current car dependent culture into a sustainable model for the future."

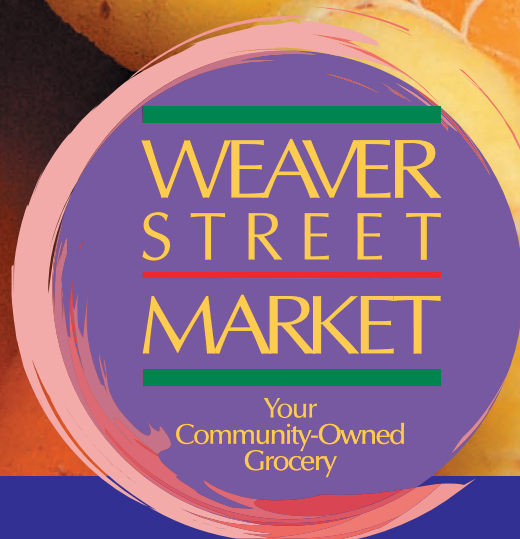
