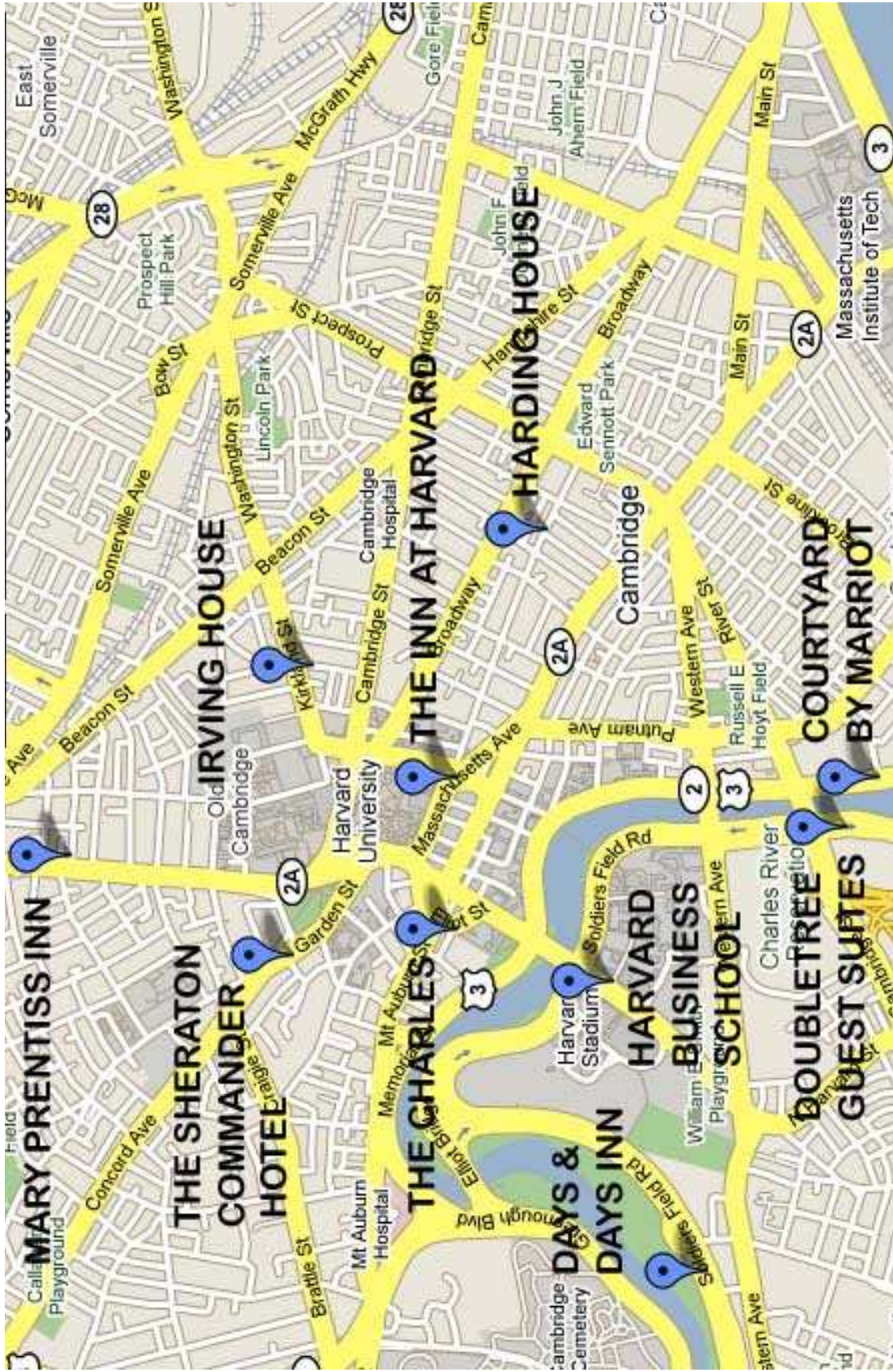

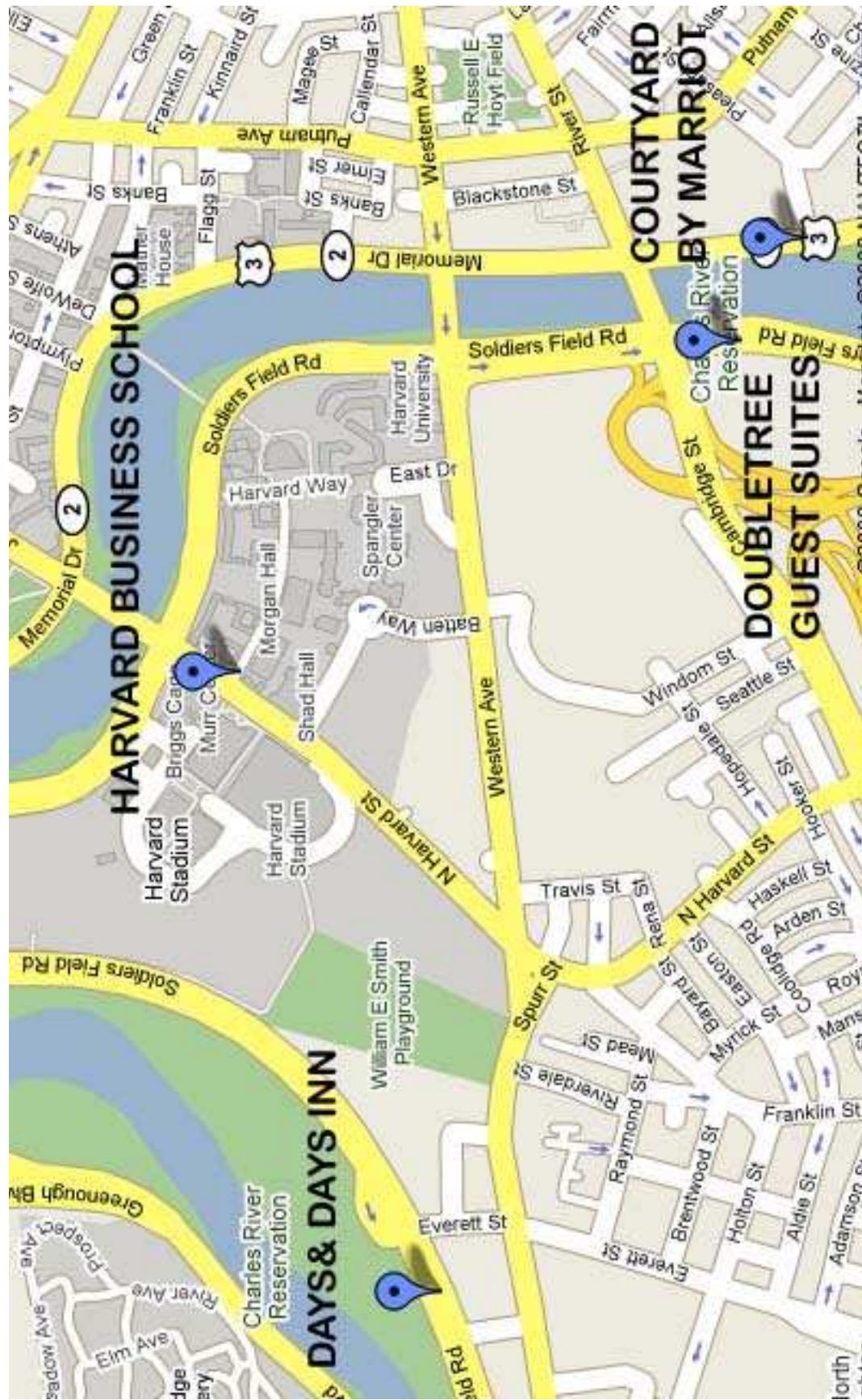
Notes on Transport Options for Different Times of Day

1. The “T” runs from and is convenient and faster than buses to take at all times. Recommended option.
2. Taxis are should be readily available in the Harvard Square area should guests want to take it in the evening.
3. Buses are slower, wait times can be longer.
4. Conference guests can walk from HBS over the Anderson bridge/ Charles River, up JFK Street back to Harvard Square, which takes approximately 10-15 minutes. Many people usually do this.

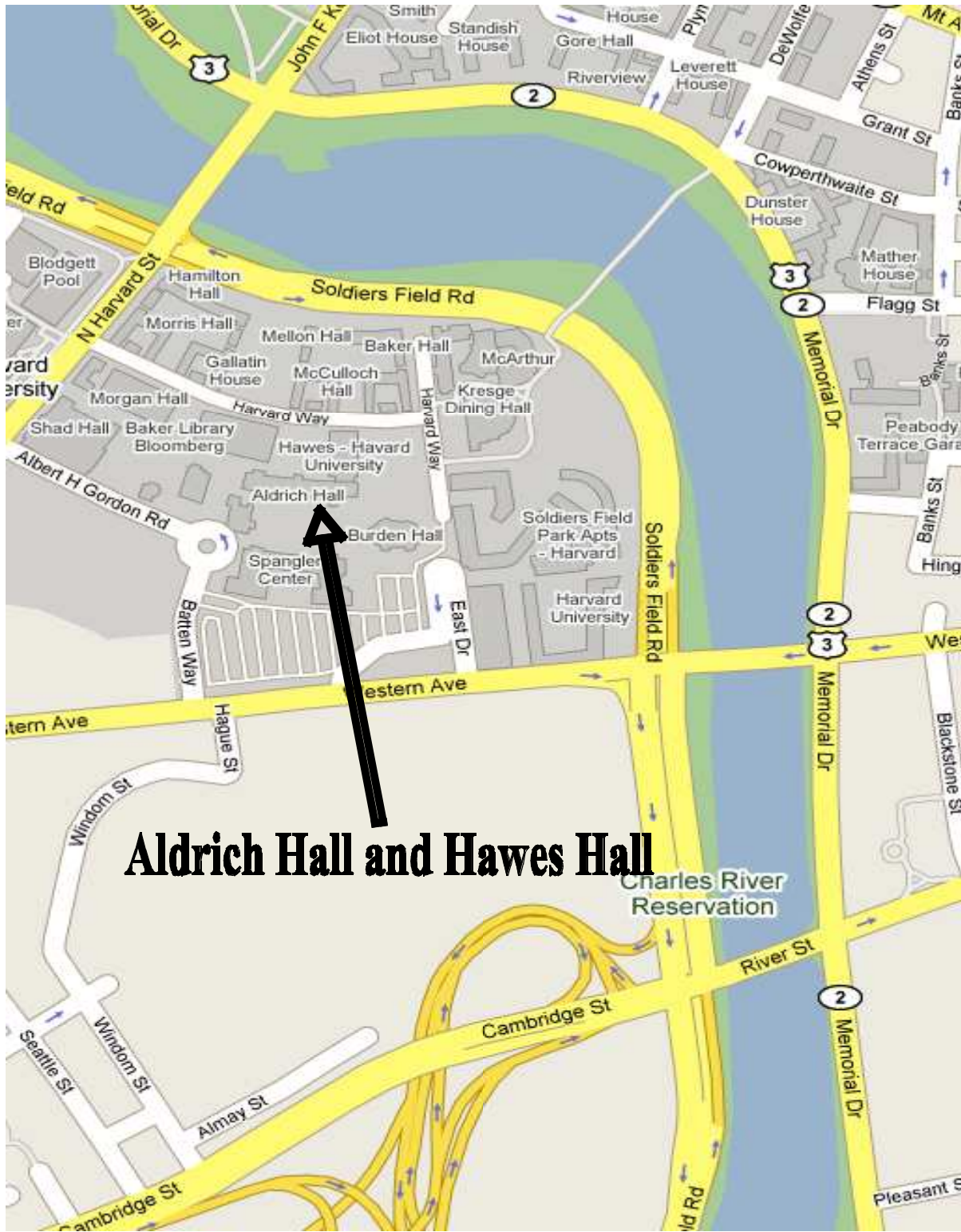
Notes on fares for the “T”

1. It is cheaper to get a plastic CharlieCard which gives you a discounted fares on the bus (\$1.25) and “T” (1.70).
2. The plastic CharlieCard gives you free transfer to local bus and discounted transfer from bus to Subway (\$0.45), free transfers from Subway to bus.

3. The minimum credit on a CharlieCard is \$5.00.

*Transport options: Take "T" from Central to Harvard Square (\$2.00/ 5 minutes) or Bus No.1 from Mass Ave. or Bus 68 from Broadway St. to Harvard Square (\$1.50/5 minutes).

*Walk: 15 minutes

NOTE ON TAXIs: take five minutes to get to Harvard Square/WJH; may cost approximately \$5. Very few people do this because most of the bed and breakfast hotels are very close to campus.

*Transport options: Take "T" from Central to Harvard Square (\$2.00/ 5 minutes) or Bus No.1 from Mass Ave. or Bus 68 from Broadway St. to Harvard Square (\$1.50/5 minutes).

Walk: approx. 15 minutes

To WJH: Go north through Harvard Yard. Pass through Johnson Gate toward the Science Center. Make a slight right turn on to the small path between the Science Center and Memorial Hall (a red brick building). Turn right on Kirkland Street and proceed 1.5 blocks. William James Hall (a 15-story, white building) will be on your left. Time: 10-15 minutes.

To HBS: From Harvard Square take Bus #66 from JFK Street that runs down North Harvard St. Exit first stop after the bridge, HBS is on the left. (Approx. 3-5 minutes). Or Walk to HBS takes 15 minutes. Follow instructions from the table.

*Transport options: Best to Walk.

Go towards Harvard Street and turn left at junction of Harvard and Mass Ave. Go straight up Quincy street to WJH. Time: 7-10 minutes.

To HBS, walk down Harvard St, towards Harvard square to JFKstreet to take bus #66 to HBS (\$1.50/3 minutes). Or Walk to HBS takes 15 minutes.

To WJH walked towards Harvard Square. Go north through Harvard Yard. Pass through Johnson Gate toward the Science Center. Make a slight right turn on to the small path between the Science Center and Memorial Hall (a red brick building). Turn right on Kirkland Street and proceed 1.5 blocks. William James Hall (a 15-story, white building) will be on your left. Time: 15-20 minutes.

To WJH: Walk up Brattle St. and go north through Harvard Yard. Pass through Johnson Gate toward the Science Center. Make a slight right turn on to the small path between the Science Center and Memorial Hall (a red brick building). Turn right on Kirkland Street and proceed 1.5 blocks. William James Hall (a 15-story, white building) will be on your left. Time: 10-15 minutes.

To WJH: take bus #86 from behind the hotel and get off at Harvard Square. Go north through Harvard Yard. Pass through Johnson Gate toward the Science Center. Make a slight right turn on to the small path between the Science Center and Memorial Hall (a red brick building). Turn right on Kirkland Street and proceed 1.5 blocks. William James Hall (a 15-story, white building) will be on your left. Time: 10-15 minutes.

*Transport options: Subway: walk 10 minutes to Porter Square station and take one-stop on the "T" to Harvard Square station (\$2.00/15 minutes).

*Bus:

To WJH, take bus # 77 from Massachusetts Ave. (Mass Ave.) to Harvard Square (\$1.50/5 minutes). Walking to Harvard Square takes approx.15 minutes. Go north through Johnson Gates of Harvard Yard toward the Science Center. Make a slight right turn on the small path between the Science Center and Memorial Hall (a red brick building).Turn right on Kirkland Street and proceed 1.5 blocks. William James Hall (a 15-story, white building) will be on your left. Time: 10-15 minutes.

To HBS: Take bus #77 from Massachusetts Ave. (Mass Ave.) to Harvard Square (\$1.50/5 minutes). Walking to Harvard Square takes approx.15 minutes.

Then walk down JFK St, to take bus #66 to HBS (\$1.50/3 minutes). Or walk to HBS (10 minutes).

Easiest option is to take the taxi to Harvard Square or HBS. Trip takes 10 minutes and costs approximately \$10- 15 depending on the traffic.

Public transport options:

To WJH: take bus #70 and 70 A from River Street to Central Square (\$1.50/5 minutes). Transfer to the Central Square "T" to Harvard Square station (\$2.00) on the red line. It is \$1.70 total with CharlieCard or \$3.50 full fare.

Exit Harvard Yard and go through Johnson Gates of Harvard Yard toward the Science Center. Make a slight right turn on to the small path between the Science Center and Memorial Hall (a red brick building). Turn right on Kirkland Street and proceed 1.5 blocks. William James Hall (a 15-story, white building) will be on your left. Time: 10-15 minutes.
