Class Rank

Class rank is computed at the beginning of the year, mid-year, third quarter, and the end of the school year. Third quarter rank is used to determine Valedictorian, Salutatorian, and other senior honors. Rank is cumulative, includes grades 9-12, and transfer grades. It is based on a 4.0 scale with weighted grades awarded to advanced placement and honors. Courses are weighted as follows:
