**Notes:**

1. School will dismiss at 11:30 on January 11, January 14, and January 15. All buses will run at 11:35 on these days.
2. School will dismiss at 10:25 on January 16. All buses will run at 10:30 on January 16.
3. No buses will run at 2:18 on January 11, January 14, January 15, and January 16. All buses will run at the regular time (2:18) on January 17.
4. Students remaining on campus after exams on January 11, January 14, January 15, and January 16 are to

report to the classes scheduled for the afternoon.

5. Make-up exams will be administered by appointment with the teacher on the assigned days. The grade level administrator must approve all make-up exams. Only excused absences will be considered.
6. Students must be present at the beginning of each exam period to take the exam. Students must be present for the entire exam period to receive credit for the exam.
7. Students who are on campus during an exam period for which they do not have an exam must report to the media center.
8. The campuses of Leesville Road Elementary School and Leesville Road Middle School, as well as other Wake County schools, are strictly off limits on these dates to Leesville Road High School students.
9. **In all courses with an End-of-Course (EOC) test, the EOC test shall count as 25% of the student's final grade. In courses without an EOC test, the final exam shall count as 20% of the student's final grade.**
10. The final day for the after-school activity bus for the 1<sup>st</sup> semester will be January 10.
11. The **EOC Retest #1, Intervention for EOC Retest #2, and EOC Retest #2** items on the exam schedule only pertain to the students affected by the End-of-Course (EOC) test requirements included in the new graduation requirement implemented by the state at the beginning of the 2006-2007 school year. Thus, the **EOC Retest #1, Intervention for EOC Retest #2, and EOC Retest #2** items apply to students in the ninth grade for the first time during the 2007-2008 school year. In addition, tenth grade students who entered the ninth grade for the first time during the 2006-2007 school year are affected by the **EOC Retest #1, Intervention for EOC Retest #2, and EOC Retest #2** items. Furthermore, the new graduation requirement only involves the following courses: Algebra I, English I, Biology, Civics & Economics, and U.S. History. It also is important to note that retest options are only available to students who fail the first administration of the EOC test associated with one of these courses; yet, they still pass the course with the initial test score factored into the course grade.
