**History of Present Illness**  
 PT FOUND AMBULATRY ICO CSP. CSP REPORTS THAT THEY FOUND PT HOLDING ONTO A WOODEN POLE TO GET THE NANOTECHNOLGY OUT. PT STATES THAT SHE HAS BEEN UP FOR THE PAST COUPLE OF DAYS B/C SHE IS AFRAID OF THE NANO TECHNOLOGY SHE HAS IN HER. PT STATE THAT A "LADY" TOLD HER ABOUT IT, BUT SHE CAN'T TELL WHO THE "LADY" IS. PT IS A+Ox3, WITH WARM, DRY, PINK SKIN. PT DOES C/O C/P-STATING SHE FEEL THE NANO-TECHNOLOGY IS COMING OUT HER CHEST. -SOB,-ABD PAIN,-DIZZINESS,-N/V,-H/A.
