Notice that an organization has been selected as a grant recipient does not constitute approval of the grant application as submitted. Before the

actual grant award, VETS may enter into negotiations concerning such items as program components, funding levels, and administrative systems. If the negotiations do not result in an acceptable submittal, the Grant Officer reserves the right to terminate the negotiation and decline to fund the proposal.
