

(xv) *Unit 13*. Laurel Fork, Claiborne County, Tennessee, and Whitley County, Kentucky. This is a critical habitat unit for the Cumberland elktoe.

(A) Unit 13 includes the mainstem of the Laurel Fork of the Cumberland River

from the boundary between Claiborne and Campbell Counties (– 84.00 longitude, 36.58 latitude) upstream to rkm 11 (rmi 6.85) in Whitley County, Kentucky. The upstream terminus is 2 river miles upstream of the Kentucky/

Tennessee State line (– 84.00 longitude, 36.60 latitude).
