

(3) Administrative services performed under third party contracts or agreements, for services directly allocable to grant management such as: legal services, accounting services, and audit services;

(4) Other costs for goods and services required for, and directly related to, the overall management of the grant program; and including such goods and services as telephone, postage, rental of equipment, renter's insurance for the program management space, utilities,

office supplies, and rental and maintenance (but not purchase) of office space for the program;

(5) The fair and allocable share of grantee's general costs that are not directly attributable to specific projects or operating departments such as salaries, office expenses, and other related costs for local officials (*e.g.*, mayor and city council members, etc.), and expenses for a city's legal or accounting department which are not charged back to particular projects or

other operating departments. If a grantee has an established burden rate, it should be used; if not, the grantee shall be assigned a negotiated provisional burden rate, subject to final audit.

(B) *Eligibility of HUD-Assisted Housing.* Eligibility of HUD-associated "eligible" housing units to participate under HUD's Lead Hazard Reduction Demonstration Grant Program:
