(1) In Colorado, in the Arkansas Valley Unit, shooting hours are one-half hour before sunrise to noon November 15 through November 21.

(2) In Kansas, the daily bag limit may include no more than 2 scaup and 1 hen mallard.

(3) See State regulations for additional restrictions.

(4) In New Mexico, the daily bag limit consists of no more than 5 mallards (of which only 2 may be female mallards), 2 redheads, 2 scaup, 2 wood ducks, 1 hooded merganser, and 1 northern pintail (see dates by zone).

(5) In New Mexico, the season for dark geese is closed in Bernalillo and Sandoval Counties. In the Middle Rio Grande Valley Unit, a state permit is required.
