EOC Comma Practice  
#1 – Between Items in a Series

Put commas in between three or more items in a series.

Example: In English class we have read To Kill a Mockingbird, Raisin in the Sun, and *Hangman*.

1. Each of these literary works dealt with racism hatred injustice and tolerance.
2. Boo Scout Jem and Atticus were characters in To Kill a Mockingbird.
3. We read the book worked on related vocabulary and did a research project during our study.
4. Unlike To Kill a Mockingbird, Raisin in the Sun dealt with a family in the South few white characters and a more modern setting.
5. Characters in this play were Travis Ruth Walter Mama and Asagai.
6. The problems they faced included poverty racism family conflict and career choices.
7. To Kill a Mockingbird was a novel Raisin in the Sun was a play and *Hangman* was a poem.
8. *Hangman* used literary techniques such as similes imagery alliteration and symbolism.
9. The point of the poem was we must pay attention to what is happening around us take a stand for right and care about what happens to other people if we hope to stop evil.
10. Now, we will begin studying another play about Helen Keller – her problems her struggles her triumphs.
