

### Ch. 13 – 14

1. Two months go by – Catherine still quite ill. Edgar cares for her faithfully.
2. Isabella writes Nelly (Ellen): Heathcliff is evil, a devil.
3. Isabella's reception at the Heights: Hareton curses her, Joseph ignores her, Hindley tolerates her, and no one will help her – except a former Grange dog, Throtter.
4. Heathcliff's anger over "our" room. Isabella hates him
5. Edgar refuses to receive Isabella.
6. Heathcliff asks Nelly about Cathy; Nelly says "stay away."
7. Heathcliff's cruelty to Isabella – vows of love for Cathy – he "haunts" the Grange nightly, watching...
8. Nelly agrees finally to carry Heathcliff's message.

### Ch. 15 – 16

1. Ch 15 is the heart of the novel. Betrayal of one's own nature, one's own self.
2. Cathy – extremely weak – receives Heathcliff's letter – Heathcliff's visit
3. Cathy's anguish – Heathcliff's passionate insanity – Edgar's anger.
4. Catherine, Jr. is born – 2 hrs. later, Cathy dies. Switch focus to 2<sup>nd</sup> generation.
5. Estate settled on Isabella, which meant estate passed to Linton, then to male heir.  
(Linton is Isabella's & Heathcliff's son, then on to Hareton)
6. Heathcliff's reaction to the news...she haunts me. Hits head on tree, howls....
7. The locket – hair of Cathy, Edgar and Heathcliff
8. Buried on green slope in corner of churchyard.

(It is here that black and white film version concludes.)
