

[5.5] Use TalkTI to develop PC applications which communicate with the 89/92+

TalkTI is a set of software components which implement data communications between a personal computer and TI calculators, or the CBL/CBR. TalkTI only works with Windows operating systems. The TalkTI components can be used with scripting languages such as VBscript or Javascript), or programming languages which are compatible with the Microsoft COM, such as Visual Basic, Visual C++ or Visual J++. The documentation includes examples for these languages. The details of the communications protocol and format are hidden by the software components. TalkTI works with both the gray and black GraphLink cables.
