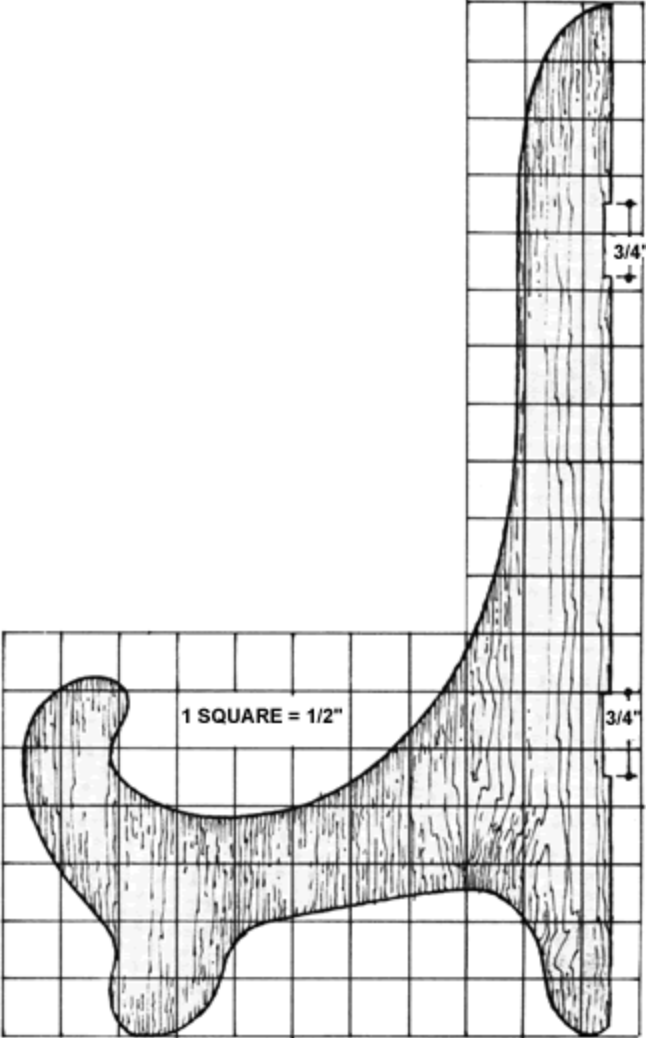


Project #17291EZ:
Collector's Plate Stand

Here's an attractive way to display a favorite collector's plate. Just about any wood can be used, but cherry or walnut would be especially nice.

Collector's Plate Stand Instructions

1. Select a piece of 3/8" thick x 5-1/8" long stock to make the legs. **NOTE: if you don't have 3/8" stock, you can plane it from thicker material.**
2. Transfer the profile from the grid pattern to the stock.
3. Cut out the profile with a band, saber, or jig saw.
4. Lay out and mark the location of the 1/8" notches that accept the hinge barrel (see Figure 1).
5. Cut out the notches with a sharp chisel.
6. Give both legs a complete sanding, being sure to that the curved edges are well smoothed.
7. Add a pair of brass hinges and two coats of polyurethane varnish to complete the project.
