### 1 April 1945: D/228 (452)

Bn CP at M946498, 3 kms NW of Gr Ostheim.

CoACP at 9 kms E of Babenhausen, T-3, 979518. 1st platoon ahauled rock on road from RR bridge to Schweinheim, used D-7. Also made recon of roads vic E of Schweinheim. Relieved 3rd platoon of bridge guard at 1800

Co B CP at Obernau, 000495. Lt fields and 1 squad of the 1st platoon put in an improvised culvert at 028495; also repaired road between 042499 and 054502 with R-4 dozer. Lt Boedecker and tank dozer cleared road from Hessenthal to Strass-Bessenbach of 4 p repared road blocks and 14 destroyed enemy vehicles; also constructed 2 bypasses around blown culverts in Stras-Bessenbach.

Co C: CP at 040506, & mile W of Gailbach.

### 2 April 1945: D/229 (453)

Bn CP moved across the Main River to 105589, NW of Iaufach, Germany.

Co C: CP at Schollkirppen (080663). 1st platoon swept roads north of Strass-Bessenbach; put in culvert in Keilberg, and swept roads N of town. 2nd platoon put in culvert and repaired 2 bridges in Strass-Bessenbach.

Co B: CR moved to 252736. Lt Fields and the 1st pratoon constructed bypass around abati and then removed the 15 tree thati at 273678. It Dayton and the 2nd platoon with the D-7 dozen put in a wooden bur culvert and dirt fill in site of blown bridge at "eigentrucker. It Boedecker and the 3rd platoon removed 3 abatis in vic of Wiesen.

Co B: CP moved to Ober-Bessenbach 089507.

Lt Fields and the 1st platoon hauled 15 loads of crushed rock for construction of bypass in Strass-Bessenbach. constructed 2 wooden box culverts.

Lt Boedecker and the 3rd platoon hauled curshed rock for bypas from Strass-Bessenbach to Keilberg.

Lt Dayton and the 2nd platoon followed attack of 1st Bn 179th Inf, put in steel culvert and constructed bypass on main road in Strass-Bessenbach; used D-7 dozer to make fill. Helped Co C construct bypass in Keilberg

Co A: CP moved to T-3, 030500. 1st platoon maintained bridge guard. 2nd platoon filled bomb crater on road into Aschaffenbrug, built bypass over RR in town. captured 22 prisoners. D-7 used on bypass. 3rd platoon caputured 18 prisoners; cleared roads in Schweinheim and filled 2 craters between Schweinheim and Hailbach. 5 mines were found at road bloci. Inspected 3rd Bn 157th Inf CP for booby traps. Built a 20' span, 2 way, class 70 wooden bridge, simple stringer.

#### 3 April 1945: D/230 (454)

Bn CP in Town of Laufach, moved approximately 2/2 kilom.

H&S Co: H&S Co while bavouaced in present area were alerted when notified by Div Hq of the presence of German troops in the immediate area. A skirmish line was formed under direction and command of Capt McCullough. After a short fire-fight, the company took 60 enemy prisoners. Prior to this action, Tec 5 Pratt was wounded by S/a fires.

Co C: CP at 246757, ½ km E of Pfaffenhausen. Tank dozer removed 10 road blocks on Wiesen-Pfaffenhausen road. cleared fubble from Wiesen and Pfaffenhausen. 2nd platoon removed vehicles from road 2 kms south of Pfaffenhausen.

Co B: CP moved to 252736. Lt fields and the 1st platoon constructed bypass around abati and then removed the 15 tree abati at 233678. Lt Dayton and the 2nd platoon with B-7 dozer put in a wooden box culvert and dirt fill in site of blown bridge in Heigenbrucken. Lt Boedecker and the 3rd platoon removed 3 abatis vic of Wiesen.

Co A: CP moved to T3 068572. 1st platoon cleared main SR thru Aschaffenburg with d-7 and R-4 dozers. Posted signs enroute. Repaired RR bypass in Aschaffenburg. Executed demolitions and cleared Hosbach with dozer. 2nd platoon with R-4 opened roads into center of Aschaffenburg from Schweinheim. Cleared down to bridge over Ma n river in Schwienheim. Releieved 1st platoon of bridge guard and maintained same until 1800. 3rd platoon cleared 8 tellermines and 1 8kg charge near bridge constructed yesterday. took 12 prisoners.

### 4 March 1945: D/231 (455)

Bn CP moved to 249816, 2 km south of Mernes.

Co A: CP moved to T3 174715. No Engr work performed.

Co B: CP moved to 403857. Elements of the 2nd and 3rd platoons repaired road between Aura and Mittesinn, used D-7 dozer. Lt Dayton xxxxxxx followed attack of 1st Bn 179th Inf. Made recon for bridges and found bypasses for tanks.

Co C:CP at Altengronau (342551). 1st platoon constructed timber trestle bridge and bypass in Jossa 2nd platoon removed debris, trees, vehicles enroute to new CP.

CO A: CP moved to 3 kms N of Mernes. Took over from Co C, clearing of rubble of fallen RR bridge on Div MSR at Jossa. Used D-7 dozer. Built a 12 ft span timber bridge at Vollmerz. 1st platoon removed ten tree road blocks with aid of D-7 along road from Marjoss to Steinau. Removed vehicles from roads and streets in Schluctern. Used R-4 and D-7 dozers. 3rd Platoon removed 5 tree road blocks along road from Herolz to Gundheim.

Co C: CP at Uttrichshausen (416038). 1st platoon cleared rubble at Jossa; maintained bypass 4 km south of Metger. 2nd platoon cleared 12 road blocks along route of advance, of 2nd Bn 180th Inf. 3rd platoon cleared 2 road blocks and removed demoliton from bridge in Chmanau.

Co B: CP at 403857 (2 km south of Rupbaden)

Bn CP moved to 550082 (1 km south of Gersfeld)

Go A: 1st platoon moved out with the 1st Bn 157th Inf TF from Gundheim to Dietersheim and took 2 prisoners. Filled shell holes with rock on road from Schmainunts to Gersfeld. D-7 dozer removed stone road block on road between Dolbach and Thalau.

Co B: CP moved to 1 km N of Volkers (452950)

It Fields and he lst platoon plus tankdozer remoed 3 road blocks consisting of felled trees in following the attack of the 3rd Bn 179th Inf. D-7 and R-4 dozers cleared demolished vehicles and cleared road blocks in regimental sector Detail from the 3rd platoon demolished a Mark IV tank in Kothen

Co C: CP at Wustensachen (610138) lst platoon filled 2 craters and removed 3 road blocks on Schmalnau—
Wustenspahsen road. 2nd platoon px in support of 2nd Bn with aid of R-4 cozer cleared tank from road 1 km south of Batten and vehicles from road south of Aoiferts.

Co B: CP moved to Urspringen, 704092. Lt Dayton and the 2nd platoon followed attack of 3rd Bn. 1 squad plus tankdozer firepower killed 13 Germans and took 1 prisoner vic of Reussendorf. Lt Boedecker and 3rd platoon dispersed Mark IV tank crew with rifle fire and destroyed the tank with a satchel charge. Asluburned German barracks. D-7 dozer removed road block vic of Rodenbach at 562050.

Co CP at 1/4 mile south of Rudenschwin (687157). No engr work performed.

Co C: CP at Konigshofen. 1st platoon cleared 1 road block SE of Sands. 2nd platoon cleared 3 vehicles from Heufurt-Nordheim road; cleared artillery piece near Waltenhausen and removed road block in Mcilrichstadt.

Co B: CP moved to Ober Lauringen (885828). Lt Dayton and the 2nd platoon followed attack of 3rd Bn 179th Inf. Used D-7 Dozer to removed wrecked vehicles from the road. Lt Boedecker and the 3rd platoon with the tankdozer removed numerous dead horses and wrecked vehicles from road in following attak of the 2nd Bn 179th Inf; also removed 3 road blocks on route of advance.

Co C: CP 1/2 km south of Ebern. Repaired crater 2 kms south of Medlitz. 2nd platoon put in culvert at Laimbach and treadway south of Rechenneusig. Removed road blocks on North-south road thru Brunach. R moved 3 vehicles from road on route to new area. reconnotered Main River bridge near Brietengussbach.

### 12 April 1945: D/ 239 (463)

Bn CP moved to 0-254647, 1 mile south of Medlitz.

Maintained ford 1 km east of Oberbronn; removed aerial bombs from RR bridge 1 km N of Brietengussbach. 2nd platoon put in treadway bridge N of Brietengussbach; cleared rubble from streets of town. Removed 2 aerial bombs from bridge N of town. Prepared road bank on roa from Rattlesdorf to bridge.

Co B: CP moved to Breitbrunn, (124617). Lt Fields and the 1st platoon plus the R-4 dozer followed attack of the 1stBn 179th Inf; removed 1 road block vic of Lussberg. Lt Boedecker and the 3rd platoon plus tankdozer followed advance of the 2nd Bn 179th Inf; removed a prepared road block vic of Gleisenan. Also destoryed a German motorcycle and killed the driver with machine gun. D-7 dozer supported advance of the 179th Inf and cleared roads for 2 way traffic.

Co A: CP moved to Hersbalsdorf, and then to just north of Medlitz. 1st platoon fixed bypass at 244658, with R-4 dozer. Chekked reported minefield in Rattelsdorf. 2nd platoon repaired existing bridge at 289647. 3rd platoon reparired road from bridge at 244558 to Medlitz

### 13 April 1945: D/240 (464)

Bn CP moved to town of Halstadt (0253526).

Co A: CP moved to Roth (314605). 1st platoon cleared road block at 273595; also one in Zapfendorf, with the R-4 dozer. 2nd platon was not engaged. 3rd platoon built 14 foot, one way, simple stringer bridge across stream at Weisengiech.

Co E: CP at 289501 (NE outskirts of Bamberg).

1st platoon filled 4 bomb craters on road NE of Bamberg Removed tank and road block; removed vehicles from road west of Gundelsheim. 2nd platoon put in foot bridge at Hallstadt. Capt Frank removed 10 mombs from gas tank and 250 lbs of TNT from furnace in bivouac area.

H&S Co: 2 squads, under M/Sgt McAlarnis took up footbridge on Main River vic of Hallstadt.

Co C: CP moved to NE outskirts Bamberg. 3rd plat cleared road between Hallstadt and Bamberg, destroyed 2 tanks in Litzendorf; removed 3 road blocks in Bamberg; put in footbridge across canal in Bamberg.

Co A: CP moved to Brunn 464495. 3rd platoon not engaged. 2nd platoon moved with TF 2nd Bn 157th Inf. Cleared tree and vehicle road block on road to Ebermannstadt. 1st platoon moved with TF 1st Bn, repaired road with R-4 dozer, widened road and fixed culvert: checked bridge for demolition at Ebermannstadt.

Repaired partially blown bridge in Memmelsdorf. Filled road crater at 304160. Put in 3 span M2 treadway bridge at 320438. Demolished prepared road block at 317441. Removed abati at 324448. Removed rubble from streets in Geisfeld. Removed prepared blocks from road with D-7 at 455263. Mainr Regt'l roads were cleared of rubble and vehicles by tankdozer; small road blocks cleared by tankdozer.

1st platoon removed tanks from road at Wannbach;

Co C: CP 2 km east of Fishbach (5299960. Capt Frank and t/5 moor and williams removed 6 improvised box mines and 4 dummy mines near Lautern. CP moved. twice during the day.

Co A: CP moved to 3 kms So of Lauf. 3rd plamoved with TF 3rd Bn. 2nd platoon removed 3 tree road blocks fwd of Lauf and removed Schnell mines on ros to Diepersdorf. 1st platoon removed road block with R-2 dozer at Lauf and made recon of roads S of Lauf. took 2 prisoners.

## 17 April 1945: D/244 (468)

Bn CP remains 2 kms SW of Speikern.

Co A: CP moved to 530993, near autoban. 3rd platoon with TF 3rd Bn 157th Inf. removed 6 tree road blocks near Feucht. 2nd platoon with R-4 dozer built road into bivouac area. removed tree road block at 512953. removed 5 Schnell mines, 12 lkg chares w/10 sec delay fuze in road block at 512953. 2 EM wounded by mine fragments. 1st platoon made recon in outskirts of Nurnberg.

Co B: CP moved to Rothenbach (544044). Cleared prepared road block at 537038 with D-7 dozer; also cleared prepared road block at 533039; cleared log block at 500023. cleared abati from road at 472018; destroyed 8 German 88 guns at 473017 and 4 88 guns and 2 20mm guns at 552057.

Co C: CP 4 kms SE of Nurnberg. 3rd platoon cleared rubble from Fishbach; removed 2 road blocks 2 kms of Fishbach; removed road block of blown overpass 4 kms west of Fishbach; destroyed 6 8mm guns by charges is breeches; Capt Frank blew up 6 Nebelwerfers vic of Nurnberg. S/Sot Frulla and T/5 Shije captured 50 prisoners outskirts of Nurnberg. Pfc Russel and Pvt Marson captured 41 prisoners outskirts of Nurnberg.

## 18 April 1945: D/245 (469\*)

Bn CP moved to Lauf (555069). Necessitated by heavy mombing and strafing of former area. Capt McCullough, WIA, hospitalized.

H&S: CP moved to Lauf. Area bombed and strafed from 2200 to 2245. 1 WO, 6  $^{\rm EM}$  wounded.

Co B: CP in Rothenbach (544044). 3 EM WIA when AA shell exploded in area. Lt Fields and the 1st platoon removed 3 road blocks in eastern outskirts of Nurnberg. Lt Dayton and the 2nd platoon removed 1 road block in eastern outskirts of Nurnberg. D-7 dozer removed partially cleared road blocks in rear area. D-7 and R-4 dozers cleared rubble and debris from streets in eastern outskirts of Nurnberg.

Co C: CP 4 kms SE of Nurnberg (426963). 1st platoon cleared 1 road block and started clearing RR underpass outskirts of Nurnberg. 2nd platoon removed tank on road leading to stadium outskirts of Nurnberg; filled bomb craters and removed 3 road blocks. 3rd platoon removed 2 road blocks in Nurnberg; cleared rubble and filled 3 bomb craters.

Co A: CP moved to S edge of Nurnberg. 2nd plat neutralized demolition chafges on AA positions SE of Nurnberg. Co A: CP remains S edge of Nurnberg. 1st Platoc removed roadblocks at 426977, 413975, 415980, with D-7 dozer. ixt cleared xxxx overhead wires, filled craters in roads in Nurnberg. 3rd platoon cleared road of rubble for the 3rd Bn 157th Inf in Nurnberg; removed enemy rifles, ammo, explosives from buildings and destroyed same. 2nd platoon used tank dozer to clear RB in vic of 413976. Made recon of roads in Regt'l sector. Pvt Barnard shot and killed a sniper

Co B: CP in Rothenbach, Germany (544044. Rubble and derbis cleared from streets in outer edge of Nurnberg. Overhanging trolley wires were cleared from roadway. 3road blocks previously partially removed were cleared to allow 2 way traffic.

Co C: CP 454975, ½ km SE Nurnberg. 1st platoon removed 1 road block and filled 4 craters and destroyed overhead wire in streets of Nurnberg. 2nd platoon cleared rubble and filled 2 craters. Destroyed overhead wire in Nurnberg. 3≇d platoon removed 3 roadblock and cleared rubble from the streets.

Co C: CP ½ km SE Nurnberg (454975). 1st platoon removed 1 road block, cleared overhanging wires and trailers, built guard rail around 6 craters at Nurnberg. 2nd and 3rd platoons cleared rubbled from streets in Nurnberg.

Co A: CP moved into city of Nurnberg. 3rd platoon cleared roads for the 3rd Bn 157 Inf sector, filled 3 craters, cleared 1 road block. R-4 used. 2nd platoon used D-7, takk dozer; cleared roads for the 2nd Bn 157th Inf, filled 2 shell craters cut overhead hanging wires, captured 7 prisoners. 1st platoon, with the tank dozer removed 4 road blocks, filled 2 craters. D-7 removed 4 road blocks filled 2 craters, cleared roads of rubble, widened streets. R-4 removed 2 road blocks. Blatoon cleared wires from road, repaired roads

### 21 April 1945: D/248 (472)

Co B: CP 4 kms St Nurnberg. Road recon made of forward areas.

Co C: CP at 454975, 1 km SE Nurnberg. No Engr work performed

Co A: CP moved to Herpersdorf (426912). No engr work performed.

22 April 1945: D/249 (473)

Bn CP moved to Roth, Germany

Co B: CP moved to 1 km NE Rottenbach (415676). Lt Fields and the 1st platoon with the tank dozer removed 5 prepared road blocks and 1 abati in following advance of the 1st Bn 179 Inf; filled 1 65' crater in vic 400650, taked dozer made the fill, put in a 36" culvert and road corduroyed. Numerous partially removed road blocks were cleared and numerous wrecked vehicles pushed off the road. Lt Boedecker and the 3rd platoon with the R-4 dozer removed 2 abati in vic of Wallesau; labati vic of Ober-Mauck, 1 abati at 410645 and 2 abatis at 415655; followed advance of the 2nd Bn 179 Inf.

Co C: CP moved to 438759, ½ km S of Roth. No Engr work performed.

Co A: 157th Inf Regt jumped off at 0800. 2nd and 3rd platoons direct support. R-4 with 2nd platoon, tank dozer with the 3rd platoon. CP moved to Georgensgmund (394704). 1st platoon fixed and repaired ford at Petersgmund, removed road block at 387670, and RR overpass, with demolition and D-7 dozer. 2nd platoon with R-4 dozer took out 3 roadblocks, an built a 200' road; repaired heavy concrete bridge by strengtening. 3rd platoon moved with 3rd Bn Tasæ Force; built a 31 f wooden stringer bridge at Enderndorf; cleared tree road block south of Enderndorf

#### 23 April 1945: D/250 (474)

Bn CP moved to Weiszenburg, Germany.

Co B: CP moved to Weiszenburg, (364534). 2nd and 3rd platoons supported advance of 1st and 2nd Bn 179th Inf. 2nd platoon plus tankdozer removed road block in vic just north of Weiszenburg. Removed 5 Schnellmines vic of Pleinfeld (each mine consisting of 24-300 grams blocks and 2 D Z35"igniters.) Bridge recon made at 345454 and 341432. Booby trapped abati removed vic . Maintained bypass at 397638.

Co C: CP South edge of Weiszenburg (360523). 1st platoon maintained bypasses 2 km North of Pleinfeld. 2 kms North of Ellingen; constructed bypass through RR blown overpass 1/2 km West of Ellingen. 3rd platoon helped maintain bypass 2 km N of Ellingen.

Co A: CP moved to Walkerszell and then to Alesheim (284544). Ist platoon removed road block at 385653 and filled crater: repaired road from Stopfenheim to Trommetsheim. 2nd platoon placed corrugated iron culvert in stream south of Metzenhof (3 8497). R-4 worked on roads, towed out many vehicles which bogged down. All work done during advance of 3rd Bn Task force. 3rd platoon built wooden stringer, 24 ft bridge at Trommetsheim. Repaired road from Stopfenheim to Trommetsheim.

#### 24 April 1945: D/251 (475)

Bn CP moved to Langenaltheim.

Co C: CP So end of Wei szenburg. 1st platoon maintained roads south of Stepfenheim to Sturzelbach. 2nd platoon maintained roads SW of Wennersheim to Alesheim. removed road block west of Weiszenburg. 3rd plat maintained roads from junction 2 km W of Wennersheim to Trommetsheim; maintained approaches to Bailer Bridge in Trommetsheim; bulldozer cleared RR underpass 1 km south of Dietfurt; improved bypasses 42 and 4 kms south of Dietfurt.

Co B: CP 1 km SW Dietfurt (335424). 1st platoon filled shell holes on MSR vic 334426. 2nd platoon withtankdozer filled 2 road craters on MSR. 3rd platoon constructed class 15 bridge at Pappenheim.
