1. Lucky is on a shorter leash.
2. Pozzo blind – Lucky mute and carrying sand-filled suitcase.
3. “It is not everyday that we are needed.” Didi. Pozzo’s cry is addressed to all mankind.
4. Hamlet: To be or Not to be, that is the question. Didi: What are we doing here, that is the question!”
5. Didi tries to help Pozzo and Lucky and all four fall down
6. GoGo – we are all born mad; some remain so...
7. Pozzo crawls away – he has greatly changed – and he ignores them.
8. They call: Abel...Cain – allusion to?
9. The blind have no notion of time...Pozzo
10. What – exactly – is time? Is it relative? Which minute is longer – one spent doing your favorite activity, or one when the dentist is drilling on a nerve!
11. Pozzo “sees” utter despair – he is blind, remember
12. Didi: I can’t go on. What is the alternative?
