HISTORY OF THE 1026TH SIGNAL COMPANY, SERVICE GROUP

This organization was activated as the 26th Signal Platoon, Air Base, 15 February 1941 at Mitchell Field, New York, Pursuant to orders contained in WD Letter AGO 320.2 (12/21/40) "Activation and Constitution of Signal Corps Units" (See Appendix 1) dated 31 January 1941, with 2nd Lt. Rodney B. Ware as its Commander. The original Cadre of eleven (11) men came from the 313th Signal Company, Air Sign.

The organization was quartered in an air ship hanger and messed at the Base Consolidated Mess.

Basic Training was instituted at Mitchell Field and has run continuously since. In addition to basic training, some men worked at the Base Signal and operated the switch board, while others received their training in the 308th Signal Company's Message Center.

On 2 September 1941, the platoon broke its attachment to the 313th Signal Company, and moved to the Army Air Base at Windsor Locks, Connecticut for a permanent change of station, with a complement of one (1) officer and twenty-four (24) Enlisted men in compliance with par 32, SO 205, Air Base Headquarters Mitchell Field, New York, dated 28 August 1941 (See Appendix 2). The 26th Signal Platoon was assigned the duty of furnishing Signal Supplies and communications for the 29th Air Base Group. The Signal Supply was set in operation, also a small radio section. An SCR-188 was put into operation, but did no official work in any net at this time. However at this Post the men were quartered in Barracks, but still messed at the Base Consolidated Mess.

It was the policy of the Commanding Officer, Lt. Ware to have every man proficient in every section of the Platoon, so that team training and rotation of personnel from section to section was continuous.

The platoon's short stay at Windsor Locks was terminated by orders to proceed to Knollwood Airport, Southern Pines, North Carolina for Maneuvers, in compliance with par 1, SO 62 Headquarters Air Base, Windsor Locks, Conn., dated 20 September 1941 (See Appendix 3). The platoon left at 1230 on 22 September 1941 by Government vehicle for Knollwood Airport, which consisted of 1 Officer and twenty-two (22) enlisted men. After stopping at Holabird, Maryland and Camp Lee, Virginia, the convoy arrived at Southern Pines, North Carolina on 24 September 1941.

During the period of Maneuvers, the Platoon was attached to the 8th Air Base Group for rations. The duties were much like an operations platoon for the 8th Air Base Group during the maneuvers. Radio operations, teletype and telephone were working on a twenty-four (24) hour a day basis. The Signal Supply and telephone line sections got their first real tryout on these maneuvers.

On 1 December 1941 the Platoon was relieved from the maneuvers and returned to their station at Windsor Locks, Conn. Upon their return to Windsor Locks, schools were resumed again and work continued as before. Faults found on maneuvers were corrected while the sections were continually growing in size and efficiency. Morale was high.

at this time Lt. Ware was relieved of command and 2nd Lt. Frederick O. Ritter took over the duties of Commanding Officer.

During the first few months of 1942 the Platoon had many new additions, both attached and assigned. The strength increased from thirty(30) Em on 1 January 1942 to one hundred and eleven (111) Em on 20 April 1942. (Seventy-six (76) assigned and thirty-five (35) attached EM) Of this group of one hundred and eleven (111) EM, after interviews for the best qualified EM, the original twenty-two (22) EM of the Platoon and thirty-six (36) other EM proceeded to Fort Dix, New Jersey on 28 April 1942 for the purpose of participating in a service test of an Air Depot Group, reporting upon arrival to Lt. Colonel Paul E. Ruestow as directed in par 3, SO-105 Hqs AAB, Bradley Field, Windsor Locks, Conn. dated 27 April 1942. (See Appendix 4). The men were quartered in camouflaged tents, had their own mess and for the first time were not directly dependant on any other outfit for help. Here the Platoon put in their own radio repair, Signal Supply and Message Center. The Message Center worked on a twenty-four (24) hour a day basis and had eight (8) teletype machines at outlying bases, which they maintained. The Signal Supply kept eight air bases supplied with signal equipment and the radio repair did Third Echelon maintenance work for the same eight fields. Lt. Casimir J. Doda arrived to take over the duties as Signal Supply Officer. The source of signal supplies were from MAD(Middletown Air Depot).

The Platoon, after one month at Fort Dix, were ordered to change areas within the camp to allow for a runway to be put through.

The Provisional Service Group was changed to the 91st Service Group by SO per G. O. 69 Headquarters ASC, Wright Field, Dayton, Ohio, (See Appendix 5) and at the same time the 26th Signal Platoon was redesignated the 26th Signal Company, Service Group. This change brought about a new T/O which resulted in higher ratings. The morale was boosted still higher. Men were added to the Company from time to time and others were sent out in Cadres. The Signal Company T/O consisted of two (2) Officers, one (1) Warrant Officer, and seventy (70) enlisted men. The company changed from tents to huts in the latter days at Fort Dix, and men were sent off to Signal Corps Training Schools. Lt. Joseph P. Higgins replaced Lt. Doda as Signal Property Officer.

As part of the 91st Service Group, the 26th Signal Company was ordered to proceed to Orlando Air Base on the 15th of November 1942 for assignment with the Army Air Forces School of Applied Tactics per letter Order 1, Headquarters Fort Dix, New Jersey dated 12 November 1942 (See Appendix 6).

The Company started for Orlando Air Base, 15 November 1942 by troop train, and arrived at North Camp 17 November 1942, where they took up quarters in barracks that were formerly stables. Their stay at North Camp was temporary. During this time however, daily details were sent to Leesburg, Florida to put up tents and install a communications system, before the next move.

On 24 November 1942 the organization moved to Leesburg, Florida per par 44, SO 19, Headquarters AAFSAT, Orlando, Florida dated 24 November 1942 (See Appendix 7). The 26th Signal Company was the second organization to move into the Service Center area. The next few weeks were spent in completing partially set up installations. 1st Lt. Joseph P. Higgins replaced Captain Ritter as Commanding Officer on 18 December 1942.

A new T/O 11-237, increasing the strength of the organization and allowing an addition of a large mobile radio and radar repair unit, was put into effect in the early part of 1943.

The Company functions at Leesburg is to supply the seven (7) outlying air fields in the AFTAC area and to repair and maintain their radio and radar equipment.

On 1 April 1943, three new Officers were assigned to the organization, 2nd Lts. Francis, Long and Dorio. Lt. Long was transferred to the Signal Accounting Section at Orlando, Florida. Later Lt. Dorio and ten (10) EM were transferred in a cadre to the 61st Service Group, Santa Maria, Calif. Lt. Joe Gratz joined the organization 12 June 1943 and took over the radio and Radar repair sections. Lt. Gratz left the organization in the latter part of 1943 and Lts. Lerner and Hurlock replaced him.

Headquarters AFTAC, authorized the use of two (2) mobile supply units by this company. One (1) unit is to be stationed at Zephyrhills, Florida and the other at Gainesville, Florida. The purpose of these units is to give quick supply service to the organizations stationed there. The radio repair unit works in conjunction with the two supply units in giving the quickest possible service. The radio repair unit was designed at Warner Robins Field, Georgia and field tested by the 1026th Signal Company, thus far proving itself very useful for our purpose. Morale is very high in this outfit at present.

The 1026th Signal Company has its own mess and are quartered in well camouflaged, winterized tents. The outfit has its own basketball team and is actively participating in the Group Basketball League. To date this company has won five and sustained no losses. However, the team still has some tough outfits to play.

This company is now slightly overstrength, due to arrivals from the 338th Service Group and twelve (12) radio repairmen from Ft. Monmouth, New Jersey. Among the arrivals were 1st Lt. Melvin J. Levine and 2nd Lt. Joseph E. Zimmerle. Lt. Levine took over the duties as Communications Officer while Lt. Zimmerle was assigned to the Radar Section. Lt. Zimmerle after a short period of time was ordered to proceed to the 465th Bomb Squadron, Montbrook, Florida as Radar Officer.

All sections now are working at maximum efficiency and still continuing their training. The Radio and Radar Sections have grown since the 1026th Signal Company arrived in Leesburg, and are satisfactorily locating and repairing more than is actually required from them.

This company, under the capable leadership of Captain Joseph P. Higgins, has reached a new high in morale and accomplishments, which make the men feel proud to be part of a well functioning outfit.

Furloughs are being given the men, and G. I. busses run to town on schedule after working hours. In the area is a post Theatre with the latest shows. This company also enjoys a Day Room of its own, which was presented by the Wildwood Red Cross.

**TO: Commanding Generals, First, Second,
Third, Fourth, Fifth, Sixth, Eighth
and Ninth Corps Areas, and
Commanding General, GHQ Air Force,
Langley Field, Virginia.**

1. The units listed in the attached inclosure, with the exception of those shown as inactive, are constituted and all units, including those shown as inactive, will be activated by the Commanding General, GHQ Air Force, at the earliest practicable date at Stations of units furnishing cadres.

2. Corps Area commanders will issue the necessary orders to transfer the units, when activated, for permanent change of station. Movements will be made as soon as adequate facilities are available at new stations.

3. The following instructions will apply:

a. For Inter-Corps Area movements, organizational equipment, including organizational property and impedimenta and individual equipment, except clothing, as shown for peace in column 3, Tables of Basic Allowances, plus trunk lockers and messing equipment, will be taken. Clothing will be in accordance with column 2 (Mobilization), Tables of Basic Allowances, as modified by War Department Circulars Nos. 97 and 107, 1940.

b. For Intra-Corps Area movements, equipment to be taken will be as prescribed by the commanding general of the Corps Area concerned. Clothing will be in accordance with column 2 (Mobilization), Tables of Basic Allowances, as modified by War Department Circulars Nos. 97 and 107, 1940.

c. Movement will be made by motor or rail as directed by the Corps Area commander concerned.

d. Movement of motor vehicles will be by overland convoy and arrangements will be made to camp overnight, wherever practicable, at Army reservations.

e. Travel by privately owned automobiles is authorized as provided in paragraph 1 i, AR 35-4820, for such officers and enlisted men as are not required to accompany the troops, their allowable travel time being that required by the motor convoy to complete the movement.

f. Direct correspondence in all matters relating to these movements is authorized.

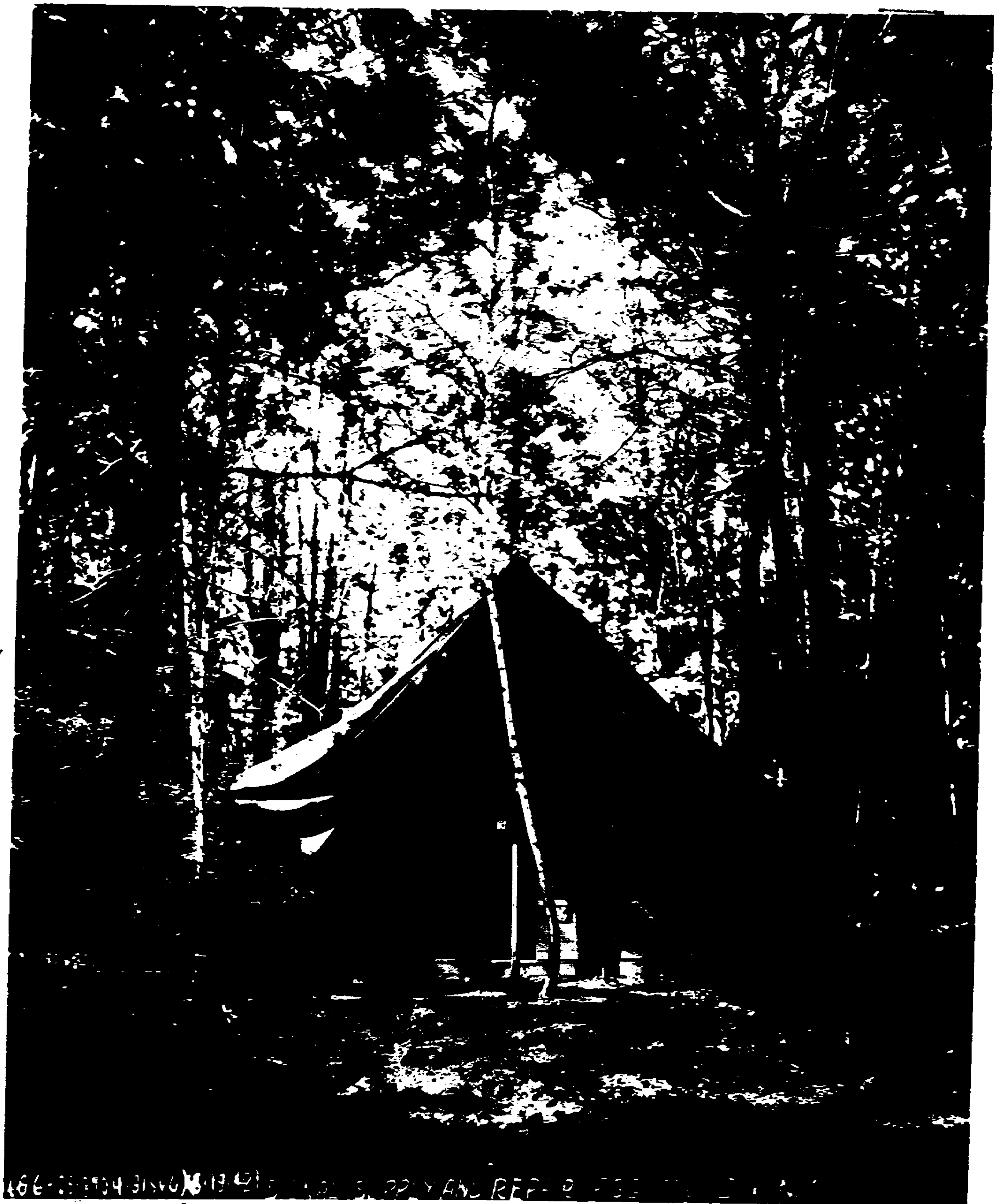

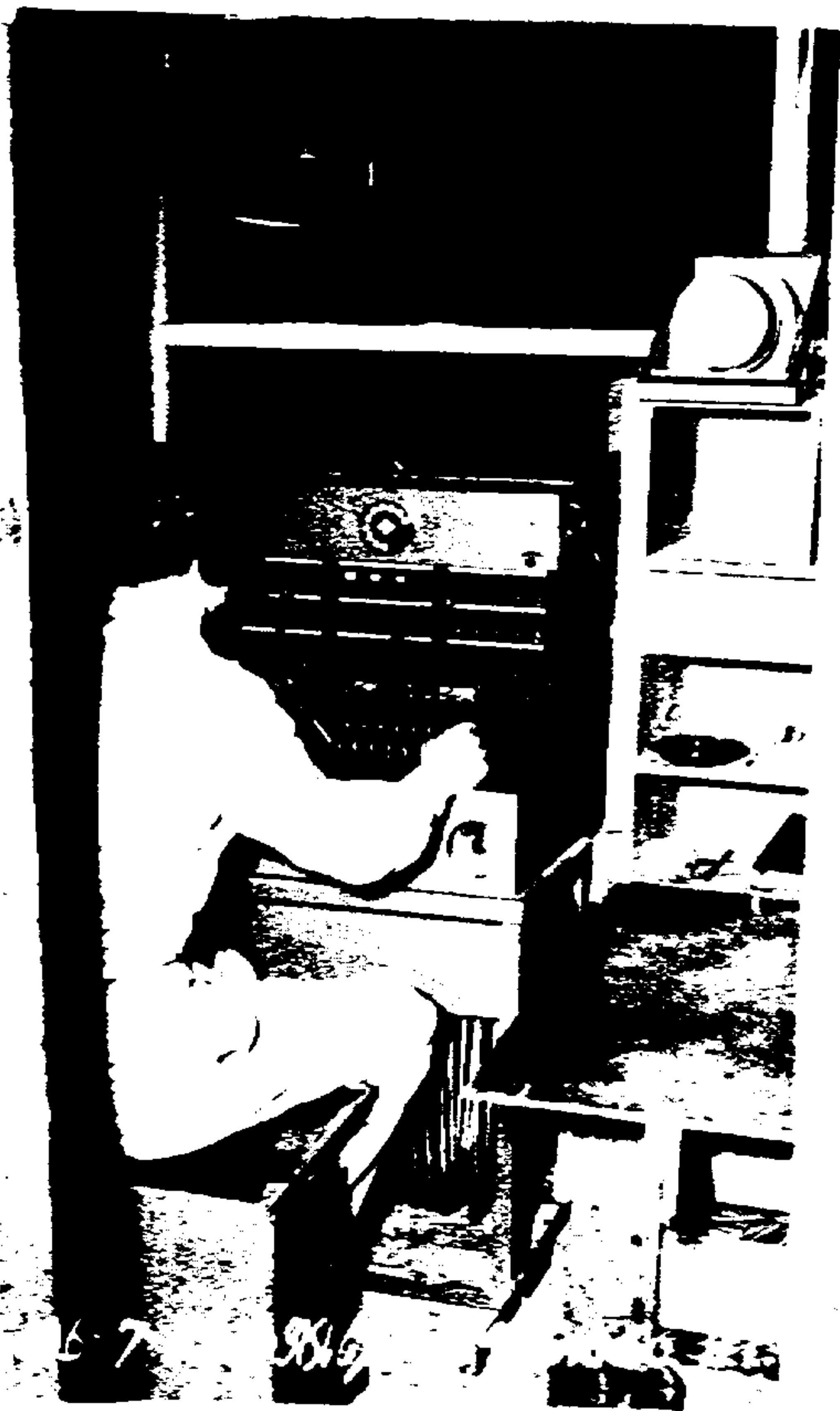

The company went to Ocala Bombing Range in two groups to fire the .50 calibre machine gun and for lunch they had "K" rations.


